HOW TO MAKE DEPOSITS AT UNIVERSITY OF WASHINGTON

PART 1 - PREPARING YOUR DEPOSIT

The first series of BAO's Newsletter will cover how to make cash/check deposits at the University of Washington, and will be covered in four separate newsletters:

Preparing Your Deposit

When a department receives cash/check(s) for the University of Washington from a vendor, sponsor, or an individual, departments must deposit the funds into UW's depository bank accounts. Below are steps to prepare the deposit:

- Record all funds received for reconciliation purposes
- Frequency of deposits must adhere to the <u>SAAM 85.50.20</u>
- Endorse the checks with a stamp obtained from Banking & Accounting Operations (BAO)
 - Email <u>bankrec@uw.edu</u> to order an endorsement stamp
- Order deposit slip(s)/bag(s) from BAO by filling out a <u>deposit bag and slip order form</u>
 - \circ $\;$ Departments MUST use UW approved deposit bags and slips obtained from BAO $\;$
 - \circ $\,$ Do not use generic bank deposit slips $\,$
- Prepare your deposit slip and bag by following Bank of America's Instructions, click here
 - **NOTE:** Banks charge per excessive items (carbon copies, paper clips, rubber bands, staples, etc.) inside the deposit bag.
- Seal the bag after preparing the deposit. If the deposit is not made the same day, store the deposit in a safe and secure location by adhering to the <u>Cash Handling Policy</u>
