

Bills Status Report: 1.17.25

The 69th legislative session of the Washington State Legislature commenced on January 13, 2025. Every legislative session, the [Policy, Planning & State Operations team](#) at the University of Washington's Office of Finance, Planning and Budgeting (FPB) publishes weekly reports on the status of all bills impacting the UW in order to provide our community with impactful information throughout legislative session. This session, which constitutes the first half of the two-year biennium, is set to span 105 days, ending on April 27, 2025, unless adjourned earlier.

Ahead of the session, Governor Inslee released his proposed 2025 supplemental operating and 2025-27 biennial operating and capital budgets. These proposals initiate the state’s budget process, which will also include House and Senate budget proposals that will be released during the legislative session. The biennial operating budget, once finalized, will shape UW’s Fiscal Year 2026 (FY26) operating budget, which will be reviewed by the Board of Regents later this year. Currently, we are tracking and analyzing **165 bills**, each having a potential impact on the University of Washington across its diverse campuses in Bothell, Seattle, and Tacoma. These bills impact various departments, such as UW Medicine, HR, Academic & Student Affairs, Office of Research, and the College of Arts & Sciences, to name a few. The legislative decisions reached during this session have far-reaching consequences, influencing higher education policies, UW operations, and healthcare policies affecting UW Medicine, among others.
