

Bill Status Report: 2.28.25

During the seventh week of the 2025 legislative session, the [PPSO Team](#) continued to monitor, analyze, and report on legislation affecting the University of Washington and higher education in Washington state more broadly. The table below is a comprehensive overview of all bills the [PPSO Team](#) is currently tracking this session. To provide deeper insight into the impact of this legislation, we have highlighted two noteworthy pieces of legislation that could impact the overall well-being of both current and future students.

[SSB 5587](#) - Concerning affordable housing development in counties not closing the gap between estimated existing housing units within the county and existing housing needs.

This bill aims to address affordable housing shortages in counties that are not meeting their housing needs by requiring counties to assess and respond to regular reports from UW's Washington Center for Real Estate Research. These reports will analyze housing supply and affordability metrics, track progress in closing the gap between existing housing units and housing needs, and evaluate emergency and supportive housing efforts. The legislation also prioritizes financial assistance for public works projects that promote affordable housing development in counties identified as having a housing gap.

[SB 5666](#) - Establishing a public school-based mental health internship grant program.

This bill establishes a grant program to support school districts, educational service districts, charter schools, and state-tribal education compact schools in attracting and compensating full-time school psychology interns. The program offers one-year internship grants covering 75% of an entry-level school psychologist's salary or an equivalent educator's salary. The legislation aims to address the shortage of school psychologists in Washington by providing financial support for accredited school psychology training program interns, promoting retention within the state, and enhancing mental health services in schools.

This past week, numerous bills were heard in their respective fiscal committees (House Appropriations or Senate Ways and Means) as Friday, February 28 marked the first **Fiscal Committee Cutoff Day**. This deadline signifies the last day to pass bills out of committee and read them into the record on the floor from fiscal committees in their house of origin. Any bills that did not pass out of their house of origin fiscal committee are considered "dead" and will not continue through the legislative process unless deemed NTIB (Necessary to Implement the Budget). Looking ahead, the next deadline is the House of Origin Cutoff on March 12th. This date represents the final day for bills to be passed out of their original chamber, further narrowing the list of active legislation.
