Bill Status Report: 4.4.25

During the twelfth week of the 2025 legislative session, the <u>PPSO Team</u> continued to monitor, analyze, and report on legislation affecting the University of Washington and higher education in Washington state more broadly. Over the week, several bills continued to move through the legislative process following the **Opposite House Policy Committee Cutoff on Wednesday, April 2nd**, which marked the last day for bills to advance out of policy committees in their opposite chamber.

The next major deadline is the **Opposite House Fiscal Committee Cutoff on Tuesday, April 8th**, which marks the final day for fiscal committees in the opposite chamber to pass bills out. Any bills that do not advance by this date are considered "dead" unless designated NTIB (Necessary to Implement the Budget). The <u>2025 Session Cutoff Calendar</u> can be found on the Legislature's website, and additional information about the legislative process is available on our website.

In addition to our continued bill tracking, both the House and Senate released their respective 2025–27 operating and capital budget proposals, along with proposed amendments to the 2025 supplemental operating budget. Both Senate and House proposals can be found on the State's Fiscal Information website. These proposals carry significant implications for the University of Washington, including reductions to overall state funding, lower-than-expected support for compensation increases, and higher costs to the University for health insurance and other benefits. If enacted, these changes could directly impact students through increased financial pressure on the institution and potential reductions in services and support.
