LOG IN QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE

Supported Browsers:

- Microsoft Internet Explorer® 11 on Windows 7
- Microsoft Internet Explorer 10 on Windows 7
- Mozilla Firefox® 52 and above on Windows 7
- Google Chrome™ 71 and above on Windows 7 (Procard office advises against using Chrome)

You can access PaymentNet from any computer that is registered to your user ID. A computer is registered if at least one of the following is true:

- You have used the same Internet browser on this computer to successfully log into PaymentNet.
- You did not clear the option to have PaymentNet retain registration of your computer.
- The cookies, cache, or temporary files have not been cleared since the last time you logged in.

Even if you have already registered your computer, various events may require you to register it again; for example, if you have cleared your browser's cookies, cache, or temporary files since the last time you logged in to your account, you will be required to re-register. Similarly, if you log in from a different browser, or

Note: You should not complete the registration process if you are logging in from a public computer.

ILLUMINA'S KITTED TDE1 TAGMENT DNA ENZYME AND TD TAGMENT DNA BUFFER

Illumina has launched a kitted configuration of the TDE1 Tagment DNA Enzyme and TD Tagment DNA Buffer that many UW labs order for use in ATAC-Seq library preparation. The new kits include both enzyme and buffer tubes in a single box.

Illumina will be discontinuing the previously used stand-alone part numbers. Illumina has also added a large-format option. The actual enzyme and buffer themselves remain unchanged.

WHO SHOULD I PURCHASE FROM?

We recommend that you always look for your item from one of our Ariba catalogs or contracted suppliers. Many of our catalog suppliers are distributors for other companies' products and you will find them in their catalogs or can request a quote if the supplier is shown but a particular product is unavailable. One example is Life Sciences and Scientific products: Fisher, VWR and soon Thomas Scientific, as well as other catalogs, carry Corning, Denville, Santa Cruz Biotechnologies products and others. It is recommended that you always check the Ariba catalogs or request a quote from a catalog supplier before purchasing directly from the manufacturer.

You can use the <u>UW Contract Search</u> report to locate "Life Sciences" and other "Scientific" suppliers by typing those words in the Keyword Search field. The results will tell you if there is an Ariba catalog and who to reach out to if you need a quote for a specific item. If you do not find a contract, you can reach out to the contracting team using the <u>Subject Matter Experts</u> list under Contact Us on our website.

It's also good to review our <u>Getting Started</u> web page for other purchasing options and information.

DEAR PCS,

I have a supplier who is trying to refund or deposit money to our department and wants our banking information to send it by ACH Direct Deposit or wire. Where can I find that information?

Dear Refund/Deposit,

The banking information to provide your supplier is on the Banking and Accounting website https://finance.uw.edu/bao/. Click the Electronic Payments link in the Cash Receivables block to learn how to receive an electronic deposit at the UW and fill out the request form. You need a UW NetID and password to access the information.

Dear PCS,

I never received the email notification that I had a pending approval in Ariba. How do I know when I need to approve?

Dear Notifications,

Instead of relying on email notifications, which could be affected by an eOutage or sent to a spam or clutter folder, try using the To Do section on your Ariba homepage or specific Ariba application tab. The To Do box will tell you if there is anything pending your attention.
