

Card Payments – Research Subjects



US Bank Cash Card

US Bank Cash cards are <u>one-time</u> loaded VISA prepaid cards that are used to pay Human Research Subjects <u>only</u>.

- > The cards can be loaded with a minimum of \$20.00 and a maximum of \$1,500.00.
- > The cards do not have cash access at the ATM, just point-of-sale and can be used anywhere VISA is accepted.
- > The cost per card is a \$1.95 <u>non-refundable</u> fee.
- > These are VISA cards with an expiration date, usually valid up to two years.
- > Card fees are included in the envelope with the card.

Placing an Order/Loading US Bank Cash Cards

- > On campus or through Husky OnNet (VPN), access the portal: <u>https://web.fmdata.uw.edu/BankingAccounting/C</u> <u>ash_Cards/</u>
- > Use the portal to order/approve cards and load cards and to check the status of orders.
- > The portal will process a JV to debit the assigned budget- No reconciliations and no stale dating.

US Bank Cash Card: Pros & Cons

Is this product right for my study?

- > Pros
 - No reconciliation- Direct JV
 - Immediate use- No stale dating
 - Accepted everywhere VISA is accepted
 - Lower per-card fees coming in 2021!
 - Anonymous issue- not issued with name
- > Cons
 - One-time use only
 - \$1.95/card fee
 - No cash access

Field Advances

A field advance is an advance of UW General Funds to a UW department to provide a temporary source of funds for official UW business

- > Field Advances allow research subject payments when cash is the <u>only</u> viable payment option
- > Advances can be open for up to 6 months for up to \$10,000




Tango Reward Links

- > Tango Reward Link is an email gift card that can be used to pay research subjects. Internet access will be needed by the research subject to redeem gift card(s).
- > The subject can choose to purchase gift card(s) from a variety of vendors online. Tango only works with vendors that do not charge fees, and the gift cards provided by the vendors never expire.

- > Order is approved and Tango links are sent to email indicated within 1-2 business days
- > Budget is charged per Ariba standard
- > Tango links can be distributed immediately



Tango Reward Links: Pros & Cons

> **Pros**

- No reconciliation- Direct through Ariba
- Immediate use- No stale dating
- No fee to order
- Dozens of vendors to chose from
- Anonymous issue- not issued with name
- > Cons
 - \$25 per reward/card number cancellation fee with a \$250 maximum
 - No cash value
 - One-time use only
