The PDF is a legal copy of the tax form which can be saved electronically and can be used when filing your federal tax return.

Opting out is easy – just log into <u>Employee Self-Service</u> (<a href="https://example.com/h washington.edu/ess) and select the Taxes tab then follow the onscreen instructions. You only have to opt out once. Your choice will apply to all tax forms issued by the UW Payroll Office and will remain in effect throughout your employment unless you log back in to change it again. To retrieve your tax forms online, click the Print Tax Forms button at the top of the page. Deadline for changes for the 2014 tax year is 5:00 pm, Tuesday, 1/6/15.
