# **Biennium Close for 2017-2019**

### Upcoming 2017 Biennium Activities: Major Sourcing Events

In order to ensure expenditures for any major purchases (RFPs) that do not have existing contracts are charged to the expiring biennium, major purchases with sourcing events need to be fully approved by the department and submitted to Procurement Services by March 29th.

Large purchases that do not involve an RFP may be able to be placed up to May 15th and still be charged to the expiring biennium.

#### **eReimbursements**

Reimbursements are for rare occasions when other procurement methods are not an option. Seeking reimbursement for UW purchases of goods made with personal funds should be done only as a last resort.

As with other procurement methods, you must have department approval prior to making a purchase. It is not best practice for individuals to use their personal funds when making purchases related to UW business. https://finance.uw.edu/ps/how-to-pay/reimbursements

#### **ProCard Transaction Audits**

Card Services regularly audit ProCard transactions using Oversight Systems, a BI software that analyzes purchase card transactions for fraud and compliance. Our goal is to educate and assist departments on campus to ensure Washington State purchasing regulations are understood and compliance is maintained as defined by state and University policy.
